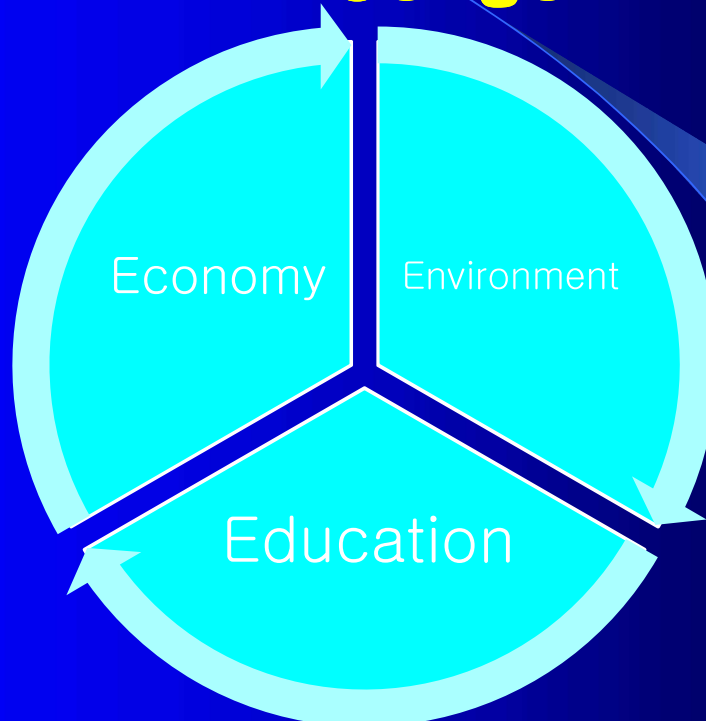
SAEMAUL IN KOREA

- * 1974 Average income in rural areas rose to 674,000 Won/month
- Average income in rural urban areas rose 644,000 Won/month
- * 98% of the villages became self-sufficient

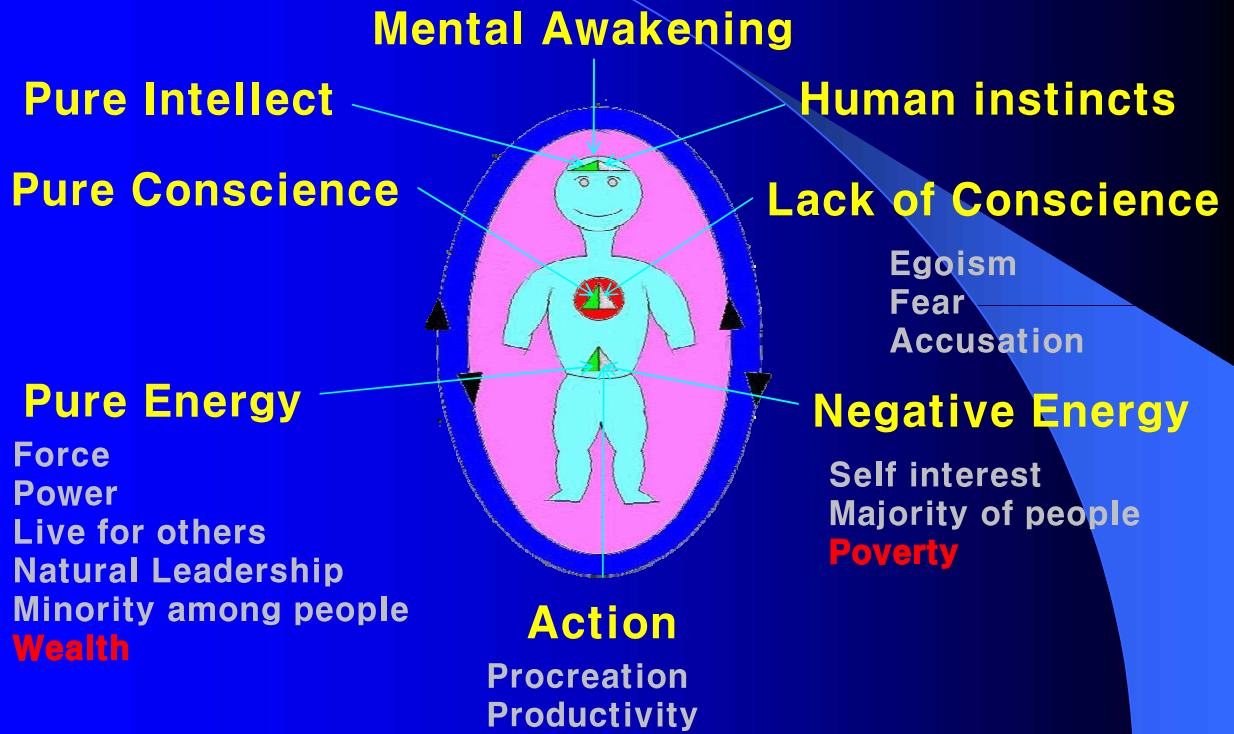

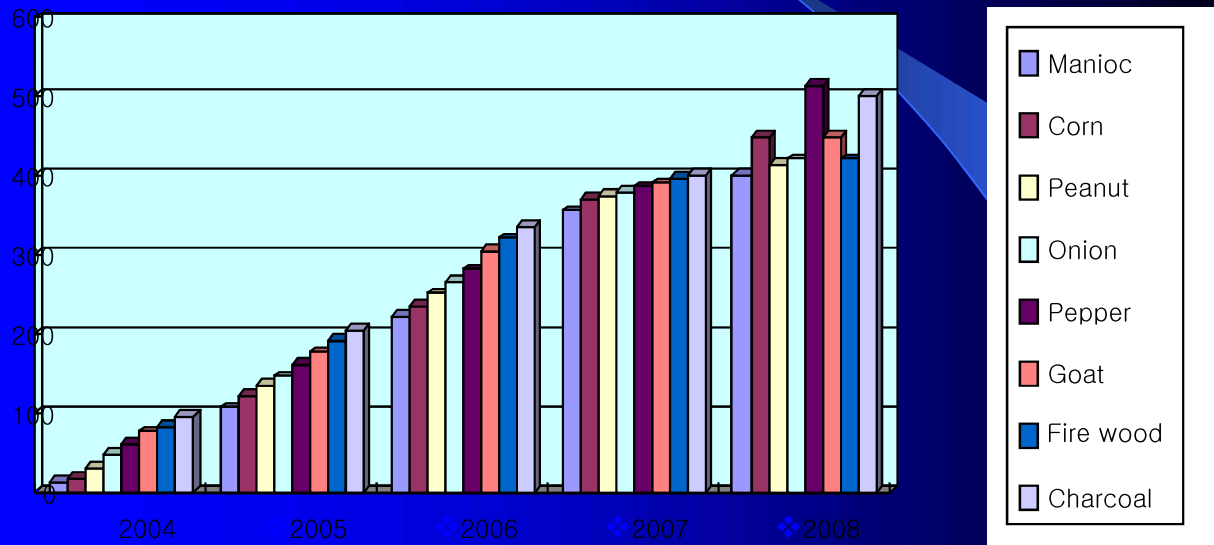




Increase Revenue from \$30/month to \$400/month



Total monthly income per person from May 2004 to September 2008







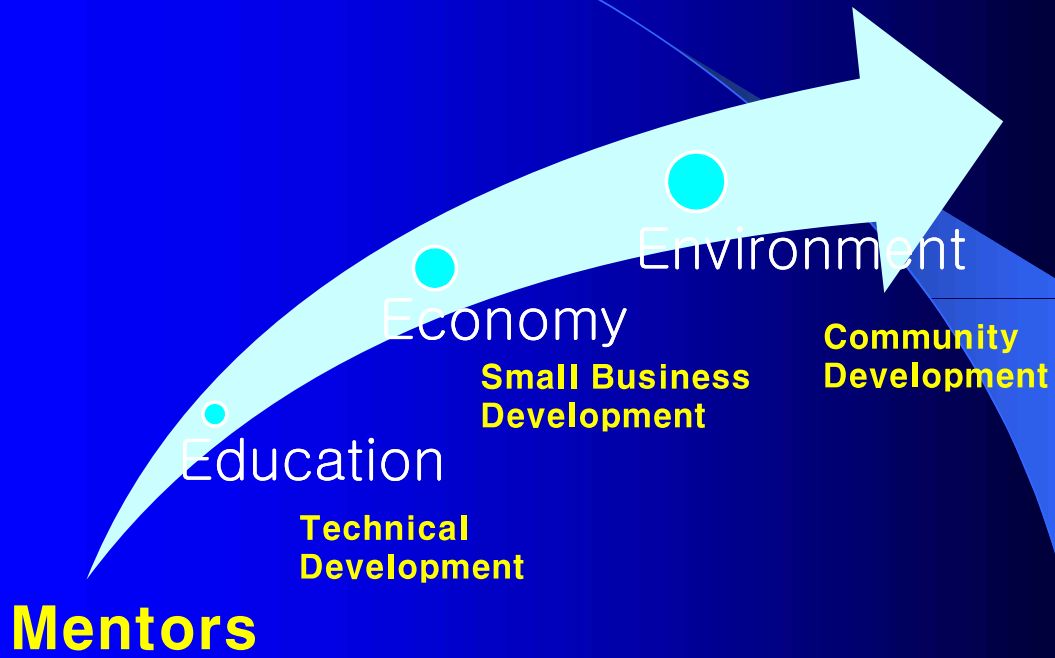
Where are we Today?

- Unreasonable requests from doners**

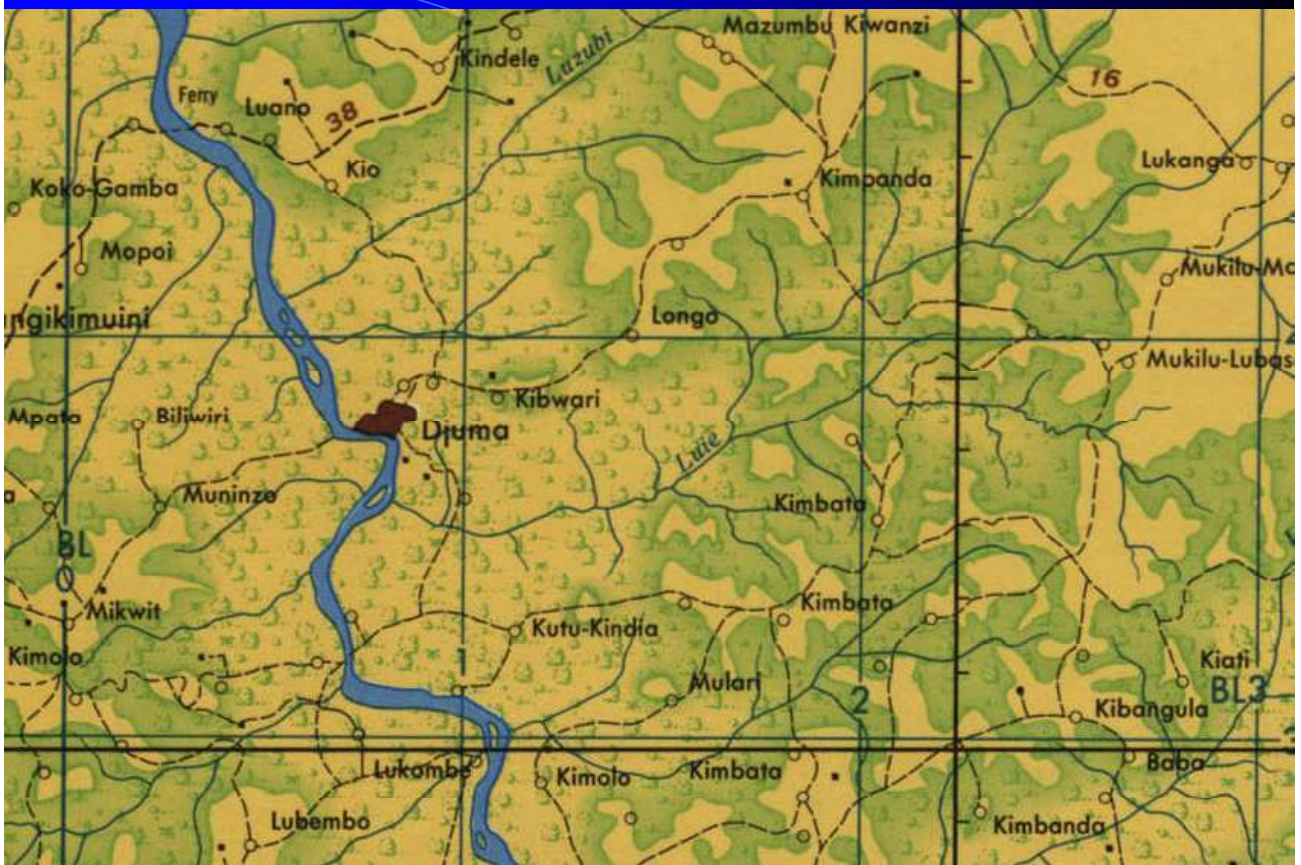
